(1) Warren Buchanan (2) Bob Bamford. Members present agreed to donate a minimum of one hour each to such a project; some felt they would be willing to donate more time.

**By-Law Changes:** Motion was made and approved to change CPGC By-Law Article IV Meetings (2nd para; 1st sentence) from "An annual meeting will be held the First Thursday of November." to "The annual meeting will be held in November" [deleting "First Thursday"]. (1) Warren Buchanan (2) Kenneth Buckbee. A second motion was made and approved to add the following to the CPGC By-laws "The fiscal year begins November 1 and ends October 31" (1) Kathryn Black (2) Harlan Jessup. Members present agreed that the October newsletter will carry another notice of the by-law change; to be voted on by the general membership at the November 1997 meeting.

**APG Chapter:** Motion made and approved that CPGC not become an affiliated chapter of the Association of Professional Genealogists. (1) Bob Bamford (2) Warren Buchanan. (8 for, 1 opposed, 2 abstained.) Those interested will pursue that inquiry separately.

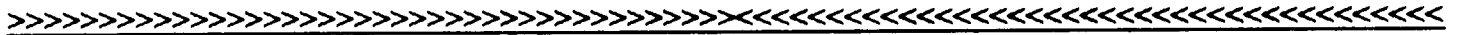
**Tourism Initiative:** Katherine Fitzpatrick agreed to work up some material on how genealogy impacts tourism and what CPGC might do promote this.

**Member Bonnie Norman of Manchester CT** recently chaired a program "Discover Your Roots" for her local Hadassah chapter, featuring speaker Lucille Gudis of Manhattan NY. Lucille is a member of APG, Treasurer and Board Member of the Jewish Historical Society of NY and a life member of Hadassah. She has traveled widely studying Jewish research source materials and the availability of same world wide. Last year she visited China to attend an educational seminar; central focus being the 13,000 Jews who resided in Harbin China approximately 1898-1958. Her presentation "Discover your Roots" was well attended. She discussed the main research methods to be used by first time searchers.
